**ROUNDS:** Record status YORK, HEREFORD, BRISTOL 1-4 rounds and non record status National rounds. Juniors may enter the senior rounds. Subject to space, a Sherwood round may be available.

**ENTRY FEE:** Seniors £9.00, Juniors £4.50. Nationals £4.50

**Location:** At the crossroads on Wilford Lane turn towards Wilford village and keep going. The Rugby ground is on the left just before the footbridge over the river Trent.

*Please be aware that there is a large floodbank around most of the ground.*

**Parking:** There may be parking available on the field, otherwise please park on the roads adjacent to the ground. Do not leave your car in the Ferry Inn car park; you may get clamped!

**Food:** Bacon sandwiches will be available before the start of shooting.

**RECORD STATUS**

"Record Status has been granted for the York/Hereford/Bristol Rounds, competitors must comply with GNAS dress regulations - rule 307. Record Status tournaments are liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. It is a requirement of Record Status events that parents/guardians of juniors entering the York/Hereford/Bristol rounds must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing."

Senior team - Tri County match 1st August 2010

Thoresby Tournament 5th September 2010

### **Selection shoots 2010**

Wilford Rose Status York/Hereford/Bristols 23rd May 2010

Welbeck Rose Status York/Hereford/Bristols 30th May 2010

County Championships York/Hereford/Bristols 11th July 2010

Selection for the each team is made from the best positions gained from two of the three shoots.

### **Team Selection**

#### **Tri County and Thoresby Team**

From the positions gained at the selection shoots, points will be awarded to Nottinghamshire Archery Society(NAS) members (senior and junior) shooting the senior rounds as follows:

1st - 1 point, 2nd - 2 points, 3rd - 3 points and so on.

#### **Sydney Bond Team**

For NAS members shooting the junior round for their age, positions are decided by ranking the scores for each gender and bow type across all the junior rounds shot. Juniors may shoot rounds above their age group, in which case the handicap tables will be used to arrive at an equivalent score for the round for their age. Points are then awarded as above.

#### **Both teams**

After the third selection shoot has taken place team places will be filled by those archers (having shot at least two events) with the lowest number of points from two shoots, up to the number of team places available. Any ties in points totals will be resolved by the best position at the County Championships.

The teams shall be selected on the basis described above by the Chairman (or failing that any other Executive officer) and the appointed Team Manager as soon as practical after the last selection shoot has taken place. Team members are to be notified personally or by telephone, letter or email, and confirmation in writing or by email is required of the team member's acceptance of the team place.

### **Automatic selection and exemption**

There is no automatic selection for the County Team. All archers need to shoot the selection shoots.

An archer may apply for exemption from one or more selection shoots if they are attending a premier event or shooting for the country on the day of the selection shoot. A request for exemption needs to be given in writing to the Chair. The score achieved that day shall be submitted to the Chair and the handicap tables will be used to arrive at an equivalent score for the round.

In order to simplify the process, archers that will be unavailable for selection are requested to notify the Chair or Team Manager.
