The 2016 European Championships will be held at the University's Highfields Sports centre (next door to our usual venue).

Wilford Bowmen have agreed to host this WA event in conjunction with Nottingham City Council and ArcheryGB as a test event for the venue and facilities (which will include tents and seating for competitors).

Rounds: WA 1440 (Gents and Ladies), Metrics 1-5. Juniors may enter the senior rounds.

Bosses: square foam bosses will be used.

Target faces and timing: At the two longer distances there will be one 122cm face per boss, 6 arrows to be shot in four minutes. At the two shorter distances there will be four 80cm 6 zone faces on each compound boss and one 80cm 10 zone face on all other bosses, 3 arrows will be shot in 2 minutes.

Entry fee: Seniors £12.00, Juniors £6.00.

Awards: subject to entry. ArcheryGB categories will be used.

"World Record Status has been granted for this event. ArcheryGB rule 307 will apply. Record Status tournaments are liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. It is a requirement of Record Status events that parents/guardians of juniors entering must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing."

Anyone wishing to take photographs at this event must complete the register of Photographers, before doing so.

Archery GB cards to be shown on registration, competitors may only shoot with proof of membership.
