Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. It is a requirement of Record Status events that parents/guardians of juniors entering must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing.

In accordance with ArcheryGB Child Protection policy anyone wishing to take photographs or image recording at this event must complete the register of Photographers, before doing so.

Archery GB cards to be shown on registration, competitors may only shoot with proof of membership.

Archers shooting all carbon arrows must inform the Tournament Organiser before the start of the shoot.

Each archer is responsible for finding any arrows they may have lost before leaving the ground.
