Rounds	WA1440 (Open), WA1440 (Ladies), Archery GB Metrics I, II, III, IV, V Non Record status Crossbow 1440 custom round also available. *1440 rounds are WRS, Metrics I-V UKRS All shot to WA rules, younger archers may shoot longer rounds. Age groups will be in line with WA and archery GB rules of shooting. Ladies can shoot the open 1440 (90m), but must make this clear on the application.
Closing Date	16 th July 2026 or when fully subscribed.
Format	Layered foam bosses will be used. 6 arrows to be shot in 4 minutes at each end and distance (Method 2). Recurve & Compound , at the shortest two distances, will shoot 6 arrows at individual 80cm, 6 ring target faces. Longbow & Barebow , at the shortest two distances, will shoot 6 arrows at one face per boss, 80cm, 10 ring face. Crossbow Custom Round: 70m and 60m on individual 60cm 10 ring face, 50 and 30m on 40cm 3 spot faces (individual). This event is held to provide the opportunity for archers to gain awards, UK Ranking and Qualification scores. There will be a limited presentation following the end of the final distance.

Judges	Gill Millward (CoJ), Bernie Dicks, Mike Thomason
Awards	Medals awarded for Recurve, Compound, Barebow, Longbow and Crossbow according to entry. For senior awards, the number of competitors in each category dictates the awards issued. 1-3 entries in the category: 1 st place rewarded 4-5 entries in the category: 1 st and 2 nd places rewarded 6+ entries in the category: 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd places rewarded.

Target List	Provisional target list will be distributed in the run up to the start of the event, on social media and by email.	
Shooting Rules	<p>The tournament will be shot to WA rules and regulations in force at the time. It is a condition of entry and admission that all competitors and visitors comply with the reasonable requests of the CoJ and Tournament Organiser for the safety and comfort of all persons attending.</p> <p>This Record Status Shoot will be liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply, as refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or carers of competitors under the age of 18 must sign the entry form giving consent to a drug test if required.</p> <p>Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Rule 307 will apply.</p>	
Smoking	Smoking, including vaping is only permitted at the gate to the field. Cigarette butts are to be taken away and not left on the ground.	
Refreshments	Light refreshments will be available from the cabin throughout the day. Updates on this will be given before the competition.
