Rounds	<p>Recurve, Longbow: WA70 with H2H (70m) Compound, Barebow, Crossbow: WA50 with H2H (50m)</p> <p>Qualifying Format: Recurve to consist of 72 arrows at 70 m (One 122 cm Face per boss) Longbow to consist of 72 arrows at 70m (One 122 cm Face per boss) Compound to consist of 72 arrows at 50m (4 x 6 zone faces per boss) Barebow to consist of 72 arrows at 50m (One 122cm Face per boss) Crossbow to consist of 72 bolts at 50m (60cm face, one per competitor) (none record status)</p> <p>Shot in ends of 6 arrows to WA timing, shooting in 2 details with 4 archers to a boss. Faces will only be changed at the organiser's discretion 6 arrows to be shot in 4 minutes</p> <p>Head to Head Format:</p> <p>One or two archers per boss, shooting in a single detail. Shooting will be in timed 3 arrow ends, 2 minutes. The head-to-head phase is limited to the top 32 qualifiers.</p> <p>In the event of an incomplete bracket, byes will be awarded to the highest-ranked archers to ensure a standard elimination format. Further instructions will be given on the day (such as archers having the option of shooting their bye if appropriate).</p>
Closing Date	20 th May 2026 or when fully subscribed.
Format	This event is held to provide the opportunity for archers to gain Target awards, UK Ranking and Qualification scores. There will be a limited presentation following the head to end session.

Target List	Provisional target list will be distributed before the start of the event via email and publication on Welbeck Archers website and social media pages.
Shooting Rules	<p>The tournament will be shot to WA rules and regulations in force at the time. It is a condition of entry and admission that all competitors and visitors comply with the reasonable requests of the CoJ and Tournament Organiser for the safety and comfort of all persons attending.</p> <p>This Record Status Shoot will be liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply, as refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or carers of competitors under the age of 18 must sign the entry form giving consent to a drug test if required.</p> <p>Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Rule 307 will apply.</p>
Smoking	Smoking, including vaping is only permitted at the gate to the field. Cigarette butts are to be taken away and not left on the ground.
Refreshments	Light refreshments will be available from the cabin throughout the day. Updates on this will be given before the competition.
