




<b>Judges</b>	Gill Millward (CoJ), Bernie Dicks, Mike Thomason	
<b>Awards</b>	Medals will be awarded according to the number of archers competing in the appropriate category (as below). Only competitors paying the senior fee may win the senior awards. No Archer is eligible to win more than one individual award. For senior awards, the number of competitors in each category dictates the awards issued. 1-3 entries in the category: 1 <sup>st</sup> place rewarded 4-5 entries in the category: 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> places rewarded 6+ entries in the category: 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> places rewarded.

<b>Shooting Rules</b>	The tournament will be shot to AGB rules and regulations in force at the time. It is a condition of entry and admission that all competitors and visitors comply with the reasonable requests of the CoJ and Tournament Organiser for the safety and comfort of all persons attending.	

	Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Rule 307 will apply. Archers shooting in this record status shoot may be liable for drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.
<b>Smoking</b>	Smoking, including vaping is only permitted at the gate to the field. Cigarette butts are to be taken away and not left on the ground.
<b>Refreshments</b>	Light refreshments will be available from the cabin throughout the day. Updates on this will be given before the competition.

<b>Parking</b>	Car parking is available on the shooting field, drivers are asked to park responsibly starting against the treeline.
<b>Camping</b>	Riverside Gardens campsite is within 200m of the field, tel: 07966 289467.
<b>Photography</b>	All persons wishing to make recorded images or video are to register their intention to do so at the cabin during initial registration.
<b>Animals</b>	Dogs are allowed on the field, but must be kept under control and on a lead at all times, and owners must try and minimise any disturbance.
